



The Society was formed in March 1965 when the old £.s.d. coinage was about to be withdrawn from circulation, with decimal coinage issued to replace it. At that time, the members were interested almost exclusively in Australian coins.

In the fifty years since then, there has been a great widening of interests as members have realised the breadth of historic, geographic and biographic studies that are made possible by world numismatics. Members collect and study world coins, banknotes, medals and related items.
